


Coronavirus vaccination in the vaccination centre - From making the appointment to receiving the second dose of the vaccination



1. Making an appointment

The vaccination centre of the Lahn-Dill-Kreis is in Lahнау-Waldgirmes. It is only possible to be vaccinated there by appointment. Appointments can be made **by phone at 0611 505 92 888** (State of Hesse) or online www.impfterminservice.hessen.de. For residents in shared accommodation (Gemeinschaftsunterkunft): we will book an appointment for you, which social workers from the Immigration and Integration Service will inform you about. All other persons must make the appointment themselves.




2. Registration at the vaccination centre

The [vaccination centre](#) can be reached by bus and train or by car. When you arrive, you should first go to the registration desk, where we will take your details and check whether you are eligible to receive a vaccination. Please bring your ID, your electronic health card, your appointment confirmation and your vaccination card (if you have one). Please make sure that you wear a regular mask or an FFP2 mask.




3. Clarification

In the waiting area, you will then have the opportunity to get more detailed information about the coronavirus vaccination in the vaccination centre. If you have not yet received the information sheet and the consent form, you will receive both when you come to your appointment. Please read all information carefully and fill in the required fields. If you wish, you also have the option of making an appointment for a consultation with a doctor.




4. Vaccination

The vaccination itself is carried out in a screened area by trained medical staff. The vaccine is injected into the upper arm, just like the flu shot. Even a small amount is enough. The puncture site is then covered with a patch. The vaccination will be recorded on your vaccination card or a certificate containing all the necessary information.



5. Post-examination

You will then be asked to stay in a separate waiting area for up to 30 minutes under medical supervision. This ensures that we can respond quickly in the unlikely event that you have an allergic reaction or experience discomfort. If the waiting time has passed without complications, which is usually the case, you can go home.



6. Second vaccination

For the coronavirus vaccination to be fully effective, a second vaccination is required. Therefore, when you make an appointment, you will receive two vaccination appointments several weeks apart. The second appointment will also take place at the vaccination centre, and the procedure will be identical to the first vaccination. Please bring the following with you: Your ID, your electronic health card, your vaccination card, appointment confirmation and the vaccination certificate from the first appointment.
